EVENT:

SUMMER CAMP-Volunteers are needed for a day camp for children ages 6-12 which is designed to give children the opportunity to share their grief experiences in creative ways. The camp is held July 12-16th in Independence. You could help as a group facilitator, meal/kitchen assistant or a field trip chaperone. Onboarding and training is provided and required prior to the camp.

HELP WITH VACCINATIONS-Volunteers can assist at vaccination clinics at multiple locations in Cleveland on a variety of days and times. Greet, distribute forms, direct foot traffic, help with screening, assist as a safety monitor or data entry. Volunteers will need to complete a 90-minute virtual training prior to volunteering.

ON-GOING:

Trail Ambassador Volunteer-Greet and interact with guests out on the trails at a nature center in Shaker Heights. Greeting visitors, sharing Nature Center highlights, answering frequently asked questions, and reminding visitors of trail safety guidelines. Volunteers needed Monday-Friday 10:00 a.m.–3:00 p.m. Volunteer can select their 2-hour shift.

Assist with Family Visits-Transport resident in wheelchair to designated visitation area at East Cleveland older adult living facility. Screen family members by asking Covid-19 symptom questions and take temperature. (non-touch thermometer. Volunteers requested all week.

Help Older Adults Receive Benefits-Call and respond to phone calls remotely from older adults, their family members and other professionals seeking information about benefits eligibility and enrollment. Computer literacy and able to work in a team environment 4 hours a day, 3 days a week.

Office Volunteer-Assistance is needed every Friday for 4 hours at a nonprofit located on the west side of Cleveland. Copying, filing folders, bulk mailings, scanning and helping the Executive Director with the essential administrative tasks. Hours are flexible 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.

Meals On Wheels-Volunteers would pick up meals at the UH/Richmond Medical Center and deliver to homes and apartments in either Highland Heights, Lyndhurst, Mayfield Heights, Richmond Heights, South Euclid or Mayfield Village. Meals delivered Monday-Friday 10:45 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Handy Helping Hands Needed-Use your expertise on home projects to evaluate the feasibility of home maintenance request inside and outside of older adult clients' homes located in 6 suburban east side communities. Plumbing and electric work prohibited. Safely complete appropriate home maintenance projects. You provide the basis tools, materials for projects provided. Typically, 1-2 hours a month while scheduling around your availability.
