June 14

Raise the Flag

Share why service and volunteerism matter to you, your family, or your community.

June 15

Learn the Issue

Take five minutes to learn about national service programs like AmeriCorps and RSVP.

June 16

Thank a Volunteer

Send a note, text, email, or social media post to a volunteer who makes a difference.

June 17

Tell Your Story

Write down how volunteering has impacted you or someone you know and then share on social media.

June 18

Know Your Reps

Make sure you know who your U.S. Senators and Representatives are and write down their contact info.

June 19

Reflect on Service

For Juneteenth, reflect on how service and civic engagement help build a more just and connected country.

June 20

Invite Someone In

Ask a friend, family member, neighbor, or coworker to think about volunteering with you.

June 21

Share the Message

Post about the importance of volunteerism on social media and tag Greater Cleveland Volunteers.

June 22

Follow GCV's Trip

Follow along as Greater Cleveland Volunteers heads to Washington, D.C., to speak up for volunteerism.

June 23

Contact Your Reps

Call/email Ohio's Senators and your Congressman and ask them to protect national service funding.

June 24

Share a Story

Post a story about a volunteer, nonprofit, or older adult whose life has been touched by service.

June 25

Send a Thank You

Thank an elected official or congressional staff member for listening to community voices.

June 26

Support Local

Learn about the mission of a local nonprofit and then sign up to volunteer through GCV!

June 27

Make It Personal

Complete this prompt: "My community is stronger because volunteers..." and share it on social.

June 28

Motivate Someone

Share this calendar with someone who has never contacted an elected official before.

June 29

Make Another Call

Follow up with a congressional office or send another message of support for service funding.

June 30

Honor Volunteers

Recognize the leadership, experience and impact of older adults who serve their communities.

July 1

Look Local

Find out who represents you at the local, county and state levels and save their contact info.

July 2

Commit to Action

Choose one way you'll stay civically engaged after this calendar ends.

July 3

Share Your Win

Celebrate an action you took this month, whether you made a call, sent an email, or shared a story.

July 4

Celebrate Service
